- a. Welcome and farewell. Introducing oneself and others
- b. Name and surname/making contacts with people, saying thank you and sorry
- c. Verbs: nazywać się

2. Where are you from?

- a. Introducing oneself and others - Where are you from? Do you speak Polish?
- b. Verbs – być, mówić
- c. Countries and nationalities

3. What's your telephone number? What's your e-mail address?

- a. Numbers – 0-10
- b. Spelling names and surnames
- c. Giving your personal details to others, asking for other people's personal details

4. Asking/giving directions

- a. Giving directions to your home/asking for the exact address of the office
- b. Numbers 11-100, verbs: iść, jechać
- c. Typical meeting points in a city, public transport

5. I'd like to order.

- a. Ordering in a restaurant/bar
- b. Food and drink
- c. Expressing likes and dislikes – lubić/woleć

6. Shopping

- a. Money, types of shops, first-need products
- b. Doing shopping – asking for a price/answering to questions
- c. Verbs: kosztować/płacić

7. What's your hobby?

- a. Talking about hobbies and preferences – what do you like doing in your free time?
How often do you do that?
- b. Types of hobbies
- c. Verb: lubić + infinitive

8. How are you?

- a. Talking about yourself – interests, place of living, place of birth, profession
- b. Verbs: pracować, interesować się,
- c. Professions

9. Daily routine

- a. Hours – telling the time, describing the daily routine
- b. Frequency adverbs, days of the week, months, seasons
- c. Verbs: robić

10. My family

- a. Members of the family – introducing members of the family, giving details on them
- b. Describing looks, telling the age
- c. Verbs: mieć
